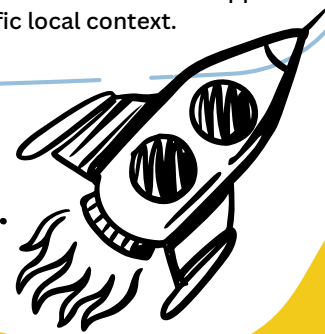


TPM and TC in Palermo, October

On July 5th, PM4I consortium launched the open call for the Place making for inclusion Training Course, which will take place in Palermo from the 2nd to the 6th of October 2023. The TC is intended for youth workers and educators and the aim is to to introduce the concepts and tools related to the Placemaking for inclusion (PM4I) approach; to strengthen the capacity of youth workers to ensure the participation of young people with fewer opportunities in creating urban spaces for inclusion; to foster a peer to peer exchange on further creation of a joint approach to improving social inclusion in the communities. After 5 working days, participants will learn about the concept of placemaking and social inclusion applied to youth work; 2) learn about the PM4I approach and its tools; 3) gain skills to apply the different PM4I tools to a specific local context.



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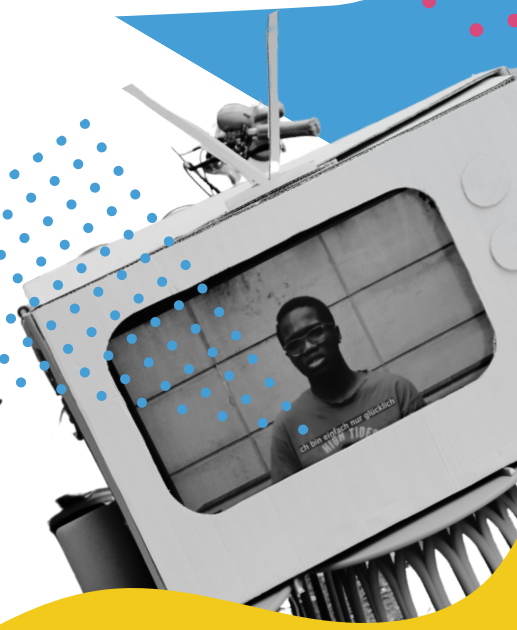
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NATIONAL MULTIPLIER EVENT IN GERMANY

It has been more than a year since the PM4I project kicked-off, and now the main outputs are finalized. As a result, German partner, CGE e.V., conducted the Multiplier Event with more than 30 participants from Erfurt and Weimar, to disseminate the project results: the Competence Framework, Augmented Reality App, Open Badges Ecosystem and Cookbook

CGE invited local stakeholders, youth organizations, community centers, young people, the placemaker Ambassadors in an effort to promote the PM4I approach and tools for Youth work and to facilitate the integration of the project's outputs into systemic and long-term change through its access to high-level and ongoing long term political dialogue.
